### Ripgut Brome

*Bromus diandrus*

- Grass: annual, stems 4-7 dm tall, sheaths and blades coarsely hairy, rough when stroked from the tips backward
- Flowers: Apr-July
- Long awns and florets can injure to livestock and dogs

### Weeding tips:

- If you don't know if a plant is non-native, ask!
- Try to remove as much of the tap root as possible.
- Mulch 4-12 inches thick after weeding an area, keep to 1 inch at plants' bases to prevent stem rot

### CA Fremontia

*Fremontodendron californicum*

- Tree: to 15 ft. tall
- Flowers: large, bright yellow, on short lateral branchlets, May-June
- Leaves: round to elliptical, 3-lobed, dark green, tawny underneath, appear "felted"
- Fruit: pointed, densely hairy, dark seed

### Figwort

*Scrophularia californica*

- Shrub: grows rangy and spreading, square stem
- Leaves: green, triangular pointed, serrated
- Flowers: budlike, upper half brown-maroon, lower half pale green, small
