

- Non-Native

Italian Rye

Lolium multiflorum

- Grass 1-2 ft. tall
- Alternating seed pods that look like small “ears of corn”
- Planar: grass looks one-dimensional when turned 90 degrees

- Non-Native

Bristly Ox Tongue

Picris echioides

- Ground weed up to 3 ft.
- Many branches
- Leaves: hairy with many round bumps in rows on top of leaf
- Flowers: yellow, clusters of 3-4
- Cut LONG taproot with shovel below basal leaves

- Native Invasive

Foxtail Barley

Hordeum jubatum

- Grass, 1-2 ft. tall
- Many form a fuzzy “wheat” that is 3-4 inches long, half-inch wide, feels sticky
- Spike: pale green, bushy
- Raspy when rubbed backwards

+ Native

Yarrow

Achillea millefolium

- Small fuzzy fern-like leaves
- Grows low on ground
- Flowers: small, white-to-pink on long stalks, bloom in clusters
- Watch your step, difficult to see when small
