### Carmel Ceanothus

*Ceanothus griseus*  
CA Wild Lilac

- Bush: small, ~3' tall, woody gray stem, branches in many dir.
- Leaves: small, oval-shaped, pronounced veins
- Flowers: dark purple, tiny, from red "berry" buds

+ Native

### Buck Brush

*Ceanothus cuneatus*  
*var. ramulosus*

- Bush: woody stem, to 3' tall
- Leaves: oval-shaped, small, smooth, round
- Flowers: tiny, pale lilac to white, grow in large clumps along stems

+ Native

### Coyote Brush

*Baccharis pilularis*  
Large: *var. consanguinea*

- Bush: woody red stem
- Leaves: "Holly" shaped, green, reddish near tips of branches
- Tentacle-like branches
- Triangular-shaped bush

- Non-Native

### Common Mallow

*Malva neglecta*

- Large, tall stem up to 2 in. thick, 6 ft. tall
- Leaves: 5 tips, broad, round w/ heart-shaped base
- Flowers: small purple to pale lavender, 5 tips
- LONG taproot: use shovel to remove as much as possible
