### CA Coffee Berry

*Rhamnus californica*

- Shrub: red stem
- Leaves: dark green, pointy, small, waxy leaves (not shiny), defined veins
- Flowers: clustered where leaves meet, small, green
- Berries: black
- Grows 3-14 ft. tall

### California Fuchsia

*Epilobium Canum (Zauschneria)*

- Shrub: ground spreader, middle looks dead, dies back in winter
- Leaves: green blades that are red near bottom, star formation
- Flower: red blossoms, tubular, hummingbird favorite

### Blue Elderberry

*Sambucus mexicana*

- Bush: tall, looks a bit like a peach tree, up to 10 ft.
- Leaves: yellow-green, serrated, long and limp, grow in pairs on stem
- Flowers: yellow to white clusters bigger than a hamburger bun, become small, blue berries

- Non-Native (Very invasive!)

### Perennial Pepperweed

*Lepidium latifolium*

- Stem: rounded, slightly square, deep-seated root stalks hard to control
- Leaves: green to grey-green, smooth, basal leaves larger than upper leaves
- Flower: dense, white cluster canopies
