## Toyon

*Heteromeles arbutifolia*

- Shrub: central woody red-brown stem, up to 15' tall
- Leaves: dark green above, pale green underside, serrated, grow in alternating pairs
- Berries above branches in cone-shaped clusters

## Verbena

*Verbena lilacena*

- Small shrub
- Leaves: green, yellow-green, thin with pairs of blades
- Flowers: pinkish lavender to purple, clusters like "wheat" at end of stem, 5 petals

## Manzanita

*Arctostaphylos sp.*

- Shrub: small, red stem
- Leaves: light green, waxy, stiff, round to slightly pointed
- Berries: a major food source for native american tribes

## Five Spot

*Nemophila maculata*

- Wildflower: 4-12 inches off ground
- Leaves: light green, opposite, 5-9 lobed
- Flower: 5 purple spots on white flower, bowl-shaped, 1-5 cm wide, dark veined
