Tidy tips

Layia platyglossa

- Wildflower
- Flower: white-tipped yellow petals, Mar-June
- Height: 4-12 in. tall

+ Native

California Buckeye

Aesculus californica

- Tree, deciduous
- Leaves: 5-7 leaflets, green-yellow, oblong, brown in summer
- Flowers: small, cream
- Fruit: leathery, grayish coating, splits in fall to reveal shiny, mahogany-brown seed

- Non-Native

Wild Mustard

Brassica hirsvelia

- Tall, wiry stem (difficult to cut)
- Flower: bright yellow, clusters at top of long stem above plant
- Introduced to CA by Spanish to make trails

+ Native

Tansy Leaf Phacelia

Phacelia tanacetifolia

- Wildflower: looks like a weed, somewhat hairy
- Leaf: green, deeply lobed
- Flower: blue-purple, clustered at end of stem, curls up on self at end
- Annual, grows 1-4 ft. tall
- Attracts beneficial insects
