

New Core Information for Old Core Students: BS in Arts & Sciences
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Santa Clara's new Core curriculum will be implemented in Fall 2009. How will students under the old Core curriculum be affected by the new Core?

- Old Core students will continue to follow the Core requirements outlined in the Undergraduate Bulletin published in their entering year.
- Transfer students entering in Fall 2009 will follow the old Core. Transfer students entering in Fall 2010 or after will normally follow the new Core.
- Courses fulfilling old Core requirements will be available as needed. Old Core students may take appropriate new Core courses to fulfill old Core requirements. See the Table below.
