### **Department of Accounting Undergraduate Tuition Scholarship Application Accounting and A&IS Majors Only**

#### **PURPOSE:**

To support, encourage, and assist students who demonstrate outstanding potential as accounting majors. Over \$70,000 in Tuition Scholarship funds will be awarded.

#### **TYPE OF AWARD:**

At least 28 \$2,500 **Tuition Scholarships** will be awarded in May of 2011 to be applied to tuition over the academic year 2011-2012. Scholarship payments are contingent on continued progress as an accounting major. **Scholarships will be disbursed by the Financial Aid Office.**

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

Specific Eligibility Requirements: Open to all sophomore and junior **declared ACCOUNTING MAJORS** who have a minimum overall grade point average (**GPA**) of **3.0**, and a minimum **GPA of 3.0** in all accounting courses taken.

**Senior Requirements:** Applicants apply for the scholarship during their junior year for use during the senior year. The applicant must have an anticipated graduation date in the 2011-2012 academic year.

**Junior Requirements:** Applicants apply for the scholarship during their sophomore year for use during the junior year. The applicant must have an anticipated graduation date in the 2012-2013 academic year.

#### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:**

The Accounting Department Scholarship Committee will base its decision for awarding the scholarships on: (1) Academic achievement; (2) Quality of the application; (3) Potential for success in expressed career goals in an accounting position. In addition, financial need is a requirement or consideration for certain scholarships.

#### **ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS:**

Scholarship winners will be announced at the Eleventh Annual Accounting Awards Banquet, which will be held on May 25, 2011. All applicants are expected to attend the Banquet.

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE:**

Application is due to the Accounting Department Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Lucas Hall, by 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, April 4, 2011.**
