These four-week intensive English courses will meet the needs of SCU's continuing undergraduate and graduate students, English Language Learners who are challenged by the reading and writing skills required at the university level, students who find themselves struggling between their native language and academic English.

Students will complete a skills inventory in order to determine placement in English for Academic Advancement I or II. Students who successfully complete EAAI may then take EAAII. Instruction has been designed to meet specific reading/writing requirements in business, engineering, law, education, and counseling psychology.
