**Application for 2009 Ignatian Family Teach-In for Justice and
Annual Vigil to Close the WHINSEC (former SOA)**

Due Date: Friday, October 9, by Noon in Campus Ministry

This year's Ignatian Family Teach-In for Justice and vigil to close the WHINSEC (Western Hemisphere Institute for Security Cooperation) will be from November 20 until November 22, 2009 in Columbus, GA. We will be leaving either the night of Thursday, November 19th or the early morning of Friday, November 20 and returning to campus on the evening of Sunday, November 22. Each participant will be responsible for **paying her or his own airfare** to and from Georgia. Campus Ministry will pay for each participant's food and lodging during the weekend. **Fundraising will also be done in the weeks leading up to the protest in order to defray the cost of van rentals and plane tickets.**

Participants will be expected to meet on a weekly basis in preparation for the protest. The meetings are on the following days at 9 p.m. in the Campus Ministry office: *10/15, 10/29, 11/5, and 11/12*. Follow-up meetings will be held on 1/14 and 1/28/10. Attendance at these meetings is required. In addition, upon returning from the protest, **participants will work together to share their experiences with the larger SCU community.**

Number of participants depends upon interest, with a few slots being left open for first-year students. Priority will be given to first-time participants.
