

## ALICE DAY CAMP

### Santa Clara University, 500 El Camino Real, Santa Clara

**Workshop Dates:** The day camp begins Monday, July 20<sup>th</sup> and ends Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>.

**Mon, Tue, Thu & Fri:** The camp begins promptly at 8am and end at 12 noon. Please plan to arrive no earlier than 7:40am. Afternoon pick up (except on Wednesday) must be no later than 12:30pm.

**Wednesday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>:** After the regular class, everyone will eat the lunch they have brought (see “Food” below) and then take a field trip by chartered bus to Electronic Arts (EA) in Redwood City. The bus will depart promptly at 12:45pm and return at 4:15pm. Afternoon pick up on Wednesday must be no later than 4:30pm. The visit to EA will include an opportunity to visit the company store at Electronic Arts, where video games, t-shirts, etc., may be purchased at employee prices.

Everyone must complete a release of liability form for the trip to EA. Those under 18 years of age must have their parents sign. We will send these forms home with the students on Monday. Please sign and return the form prior to the field trip if you wish to participate. There will be no on-site care for those not attending the field trip.

**Food:** **No snacks or meals will be provided – either in the day camp or during the site visit to EA.** Please plan to eat breakfast before arriving, and bring a snack every day. If you are going to EA on Wednesday, be sure to bring a snack lunch, something to drink and any snacks you will need.

**Drop-off and Pick-up:** From the El Camino Real, turn into the main entrance of the campus onto Palm Drive. Go about 100 feet past the guard house and turn left at the first four-way intersection. Turn right into the parking lot (“X”) in front of Bannan Hall. Students should proceed directly to the computer labs on the second floor of building 402.
