

I presented on the topic proposed for the grant this past July: "Gendered Vulnerability: Exploitation of Women on the Move," Second Conference of Catholic Theological Ethics in the World Church, "In the Currents of History: From Trent to the Future," Trent Italy, July 24-27, 2010.

Part of that research was also incorporated into a lecture I delivered in September, as well: "Reservoirs of Hope and Resilience: Catholic Women's Witness," The Annual Anne Drummey O'Callaghan Lecture on Women in the Church, Fairfield University, October 6, 2010. (A portion of this may be turned into an America magazine submission in the new year).

Finally, the grant-related research continues to develop as a book chapter (three) in my manuscript, *Kinship and Justice: Christian Perspectives on Immigration*, under contract with Georgetown University Press, (Moral Traditions series).
