Campus Activities

From 12 to 50 affiliated scholars with interests in the ethical dimension of disciplines from economics to literature and engineering





Public Programs

From an occasional speaker to a world-class series with headliners such as Leon Panetta, Hans Küng, Richard Rodriguez, and Brandi Chastain

From a workshop on nursing ethics to a wide-ranging set of roundtables, training sessions, and ethics camps for businesspeople, government officials, health care professionals, and teachers

From an academic symposium on affirmative action to a rich menu of panels and conferences: “Global Business Ethics,” “IT, Ethics, Law, and Society,” “Ethics and the New Media”

From a four-page newsletter to a 4,000-page Web site averaging more than 12,000 page views daily

From a basic “Framework for Ethical Decision Making” to primers on government ethics; medical ethics; and religion, ethics, and politics in world affairs

From a few lesson plans in character education to a full curriculum in Character-Based language arts, social studies, and science, in use at thousands of schools throughout the United States
