Limit your response to approximately 3 pages or about 1500 words.*

- 1) Provide your name, student I.D. number, local mailing address, email, phone number, major, cumulative GPA, and anticipated date of graduation.
- 2) Describe the project you are proposing in as much detail as possible.
 - a) Give a brief summary of the project.
 - b) If you are working through an agency, parish or diocese, provide the organization's information and literature as well.
 - c) If you plan to attend a seminar or other education program, provide brochures or flyers describing the program.
 - d) If necessary, feel free to hand deliver the agency literature, in an envelope, with your name, William C. Spohn Student Fellowship for the Study of Religion and Public Life, ATTN: Paul Woolley, to the Ignatian Center, Sobrato Hall, Room 34 by the application deadline.
- 3) Provide a basic budget for your project, including
 - a) all costs (transportation, lodging, fees, etc.);
 - b) all sources of funding with specific amounts from each;
 - c) the amount you are requesting from the Ignatian Center, maximum of \$2,500.
- 4) Answer the following questions:
 - a) Why do you wish to be a part of the Ignatian Center's Student Fellowship for the Study of Religion and Public Life?
 - b) How does such an internship relate to your future plans, deepest longings and professional goals?
 - c) What experiences have led you to pursue this fellowship?
 - d) What are your principal areas of intellectual interest?
 - e) How will this proposed project enable you to *integrate* your intellectual, community, and personal endeavors into your interest in religion and public life?
 - f) How did you learn about the William C. Spohn Student Fellowship for the Study of Religion and Public Life (newspaper, web page, Career Center, word of mouth, flier, other)?
- 5) Include the name of a faculty advisor who has agreed to accompany you through this student fellowship. Also include a name and contact information of a faculty, staff, or community member (e.g., pastor, employer, community mentor, etc.) who knows you, knows of your project plans, and could serve as a reference. Please ask his or her permission beforehand and inform your reference that we may be contacting him or her.
