







The Santa Clara Survey of recent graduates connects employment, education, civic, and satisfaction outcomes to measure the impact of a Santa Clara education. Conducted annually at six-months post-graduation, the 36.2% response rate yields a profile that is representative of the graduating class. Initiated with the class of 2008, these longitudinal data track Santa Clara's progress to ensure an education of citizens and leaders of competence, conscience, and compassion.
