

Instructions for Residence Hall Move-in

In order to provide for the safe and efficient move-in of returning students and to provide a welcoming atmosphere for the beginning of the year, the Offices of Housing and Residence Life and Campus Safety Services have developed the following procedures.

All returning students move in on Sunday, September 19, 2010 between 9 am and 4 pm by going to the service desk of their assigned community. Returning students with an early arrival approval may check-in at the Kennedy Commons Service Desk on the appointed day between **9 am and 4 pm. Students without early arrival approval should not plan on arriving to campus, or dropping off belongings, until September 19th.**

Campus checkpoints have been created for all residence halls and they are:

McLaughlin, Nobili and Walsh:	#1 Santa Clara Street and Lafayette Street (Tire trap will be lowered)
Campisi, Sanfilippo, & Casa Italiana:	#2 Accolti Way
Bellarmino	#3 Bellarmino Parking Lot (Off of The Alameda-South Side)
Sobrato	#4 Sobrato Parking Lot (Off of The Alameda-North Side)
Graham, Swig and Dunne:	#5 Intersection of Bellomy and The Alameda (along with Market St.)
St. Clare	#6 St. Clare Parking Lot

Once you have successfully entered your assigned campus check point, cars will be directed to an unloading area by Campus Safety officers. Upon arriving in the unloading area, the resident student should proceed to the service desk of their assigned residence hall to receive keys and paperwork. Parents, friends or other family members **must remain with the vehicle at all times. Unattended vehicles risk being ticketed and towed.**
