2.1 General Description

The corporate title of the University is “The President and Board of Trustees of Santa Clara College.”

The University is divided into three major administrative areas: Provost, Administration and Finance, and University Relations. The head of each of these areas reports directly to the President of the University.

Instruction and research are conducted within five major academic units: the College of Arts and Sciences, the Thomas and Dorothy Leavey School of Business, the School of Engineering, the School of Law, and the School of Education, Counseling Psychology and Education. Each of these areas is headed by a dean reporting directly to the Provost.

Academic administrators at all levels have specific responsibilities in formulating and implementing academic plans. The faculty have general responsibility for contributing to this process.
