Each award provides up to \$10,000 for summer research including wages, benefits, supplies and research-related travel. Clare Booth Luce Research Scholar awards are for women majoring in the natural sciences and engineering. Pre-medical science majors are ineligible for these awards. An overall GPA of 3.25 or higher is required at the time of the award. Only U.S. citizens may receive Clare Boothe Luce funding.

Submit proposals to [grants@scu.edu](mailto:grants@scu.edu). Please include the type of grant you are applying for in the subject line (i.e. Clare Boothe Luce Scholar). **Electronic submission of proposals is required.**

**Deadline: January 20, 2012**

Proposals must not exceed **5** pages include the following information.

1. Student Information (Name, SCU I.D. number, local address, telephone, e-mail address, Major(s)/Minor(s), overall G.P.A., and expected graduation date)
2. Research Project Title
3. Research Project Description (accessible to non-specialist)
4. Project Plan: Include a clear definition of the research problem, a brief research/creative work design outline, and the significance of the proposed work.
5. Expected outcomes, with a timeline including anticipated presentations, creative works and/or publications.
6. Previous Research Experience
7. Career Goals
8. Budget Detail (up to \$10,000; international travel is NOT allowed with CLB funds, salary must be based on \$15/hr.)

In addition to the information above, *a separate letter of support from the faculty mentor must be included.*
