

Cultures and Idea FCC meeting, Friday February 8, 3:30-5

In attendance were Phyllis Brown, Teresia Hinga, Lisa Kealhofer, Scott LaBarge, Arthur Liebscher, Barbara Molony, and Andrea Pappas.

Committee members approved the revised minutes from the January 18 meeting.

Phyllis provided “Guidelines and reminder” from the FCC chairs meeting February 6, 2008.

Several revisions in the Goals, Objectives, and Guidelines document were suggested, to clarify differences between C & I 1 and 2 more fully and helpfully. Art expressed some concern about the third and fourth items in the Guidelines list; he offered to draft language that will clarify the emphasis on different perspectives rather than suggest that the perspectives the students bring to the class will dominate. Phyllis will send the revised document to the committee for review and to Kristin Boscia for posting on the Core2009 web site.

The committee agreed to divide up the honorarium proposals so that three members of the committee will draft recommendations and comments for each proposal. It was agreed that Phyllis will invite Barb Fraser to join her honorarium group, and that Phyllis will talk to Roseanne Quinn and Megan Williams about the possibility of their proposal being shifted to Critical Thinking and Writing.
