

## **Faculty Membership Guidelines for Faculty Core Committees**

**This list includes only those eligible to serve as faculty representatives on FCCs. It does not include consultants or ex officio members of FCCs.**

### Arts

- One member from each of the three departments in the Arts (Art, Music, Theater & Dance)
- One member from English
- One member from a department in the Humanities other than the departments identified above, or from a department in the Social Sciences

### C&I 1 and 2

- Four members from different departments in the Humanities
- One member from the Social Sciences

### C&I 3

- Two members from different departments in the Humanities
- One member from the Social Sciences
- One member from the School of Business

### CE

- One member from a department in the Business School
- Three members from different departments in the Social Sciences or Humanities

### DIV

- One member from WGST
- One member from Ethnic Studies
- One member from a department/academic program in Arts and Sciences other than WGST and Ethnic Studies
- One member from the School of Business or the School of Engineering

### ELSJ

- One member from the School of Business
- One member from the Humanities or Arts
- One member from the Social or Natural Sciences
- One member from the School of Engineering

### Ethics

- Two members from the Philosophy Department
- One member from the School of Business
- One member from a department other than Philosophy in the Arts and Sciences, or from a department in the School of Engineering

#### Math

- Two members from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science
- One member from Engineering or the Natural Sciences

#### Natural Science

- Four members from different departments in the Natural Sciences broadly defined (Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Studies and Sciences, Physics, Public Health Science, Psychology,)
- One member from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science Department or from a department in the School of Engineering

#### Pathways

- One member from the Humanities
- One member from the Social Sciences
- One member from Mathematics or the Natural Sciences
- One member from the School of Business
- One member from the School of Engineering

#### Religion, Theology & culture

- Three members from the Religious Studies Department
- Two members from different departments in the College of Arts and Sciences

#### Second Language

- Two members from the Modern Languages Department
- One member from the Classics Department

#### Social Science

- One member from the School of Business
- Three members from different departments in the Social Sciences broadly defined (Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science, Liberal Studies, Ethnic Studies, Women's & Gender Studies)

#### STS

- Two members from different departments in the Natural Sciences
- Two members from different departments in the Humanities or Social Sciences
- One member from the School of Engineering

#### Writing

- Two members from the English Department
- Two members from different undergraduate departments other than English
