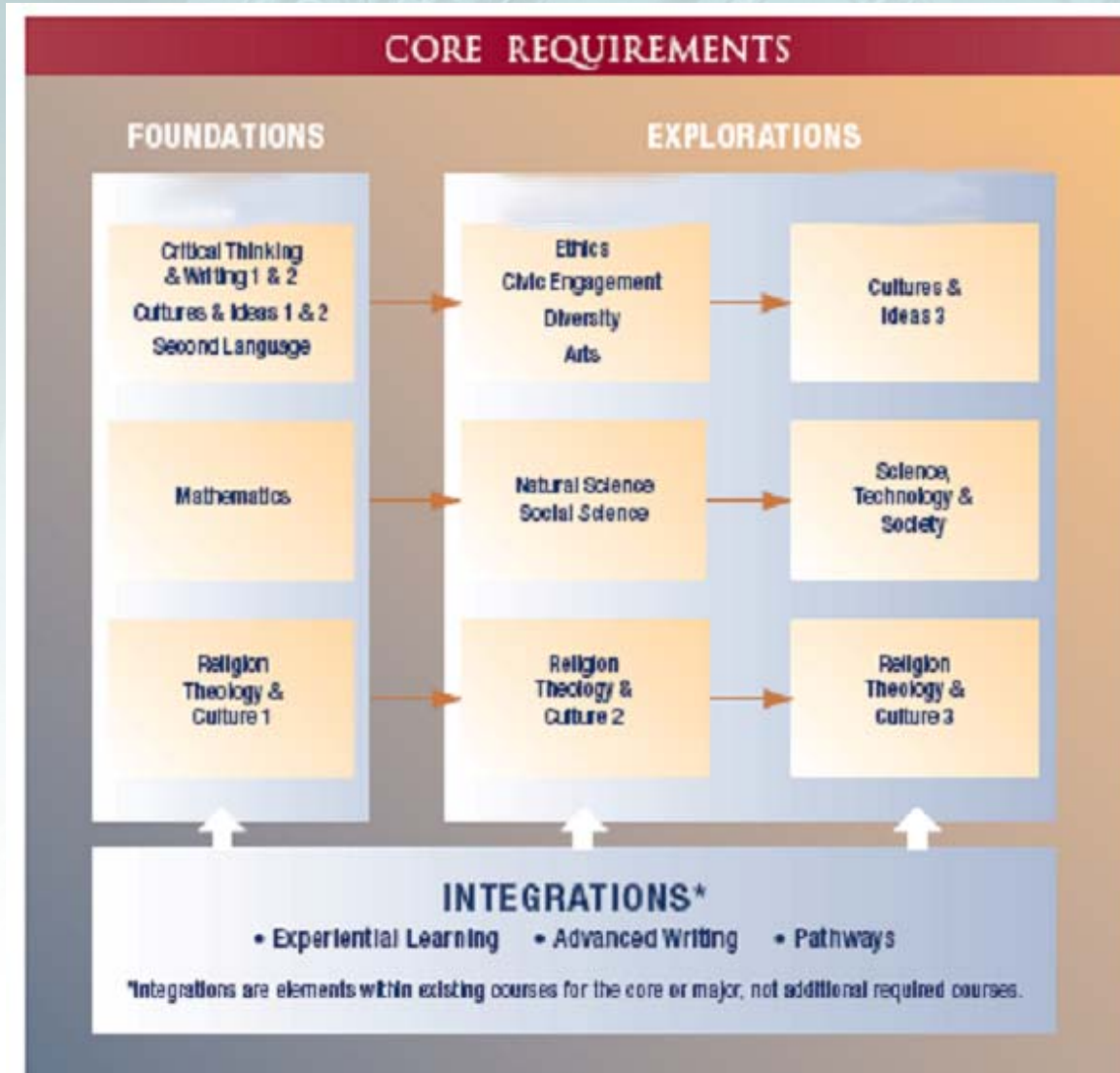

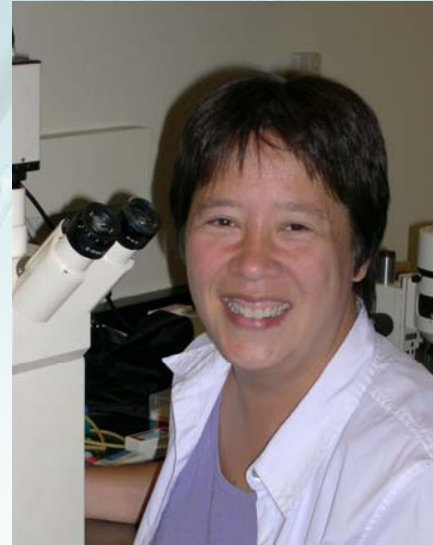

# The New Core Curriculum

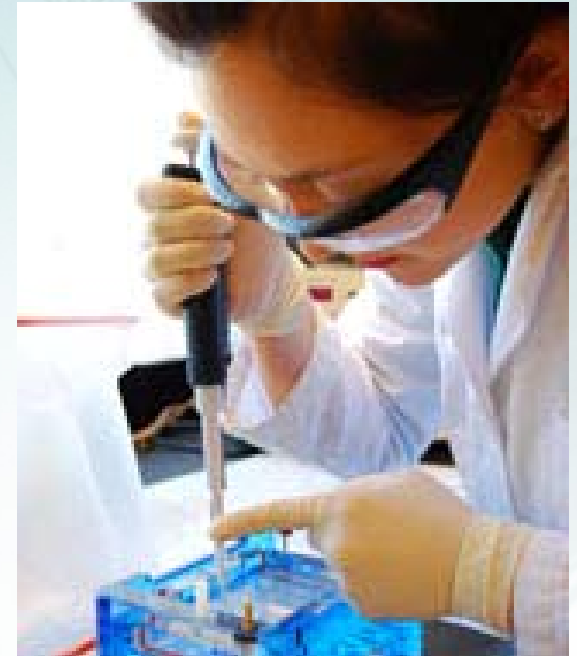

# Fall 2009 Implementation

- 134 sections of new CTW 1 & 2
- 92 sections of new C&I 1 & 2
- 46 sections of RTC 1
- 30 sections of core mathematics (40 sections more for engineers and natural science majors)
- 110 sections of core language
- 32 sections of social science
- 29 sections of natural science (plus labs for all)

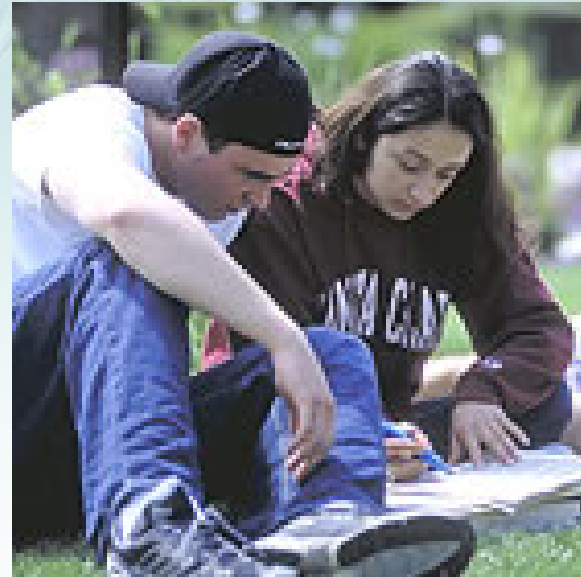
