Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A or English 1AH and 1B
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 5A, 5B, 12, or 13.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One natural science course with a lab such as Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 3/8A, 4/8A, 10/8A, 11/8A; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 4, 5, 6, 11A, 11B, 11C, 13A/13L; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A/L, 12B/L; Geography 1/L; Geology 10; Meteorology 1/1L; Oceanography 10; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L, 11.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences of such as Art History 20A, 20B; History 4A, 4B; History 4AH, 4BH; Philosophy 6, 7.
- 5) **Math or Biological/Physical Science:** One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Astronomy 3, 4, 10, 11; Environmental Science 10; Physics 10.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 2; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 1H, 2, 3, 5; Psychology 1, 6, 33; Sociology 1, 2, 3, 5.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Anthropology 16; Art History 18; English 24A, 24B, 30A, 30B, 39, 41A, 41B; History 14, 15, 17A, 17AH, 17B, 18A, 18B, 21A, 21B, 23, 29A, 29B; Political Science 1, 1H, 5; Sociology 3.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 6, 17; Communication 12; English 24A, 24B, 39, 41A, 41B; History 14, 18A, 18B, 21A, 21B, 23, 29A, 29B; Sociology 3, 5; Women's Studies 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 13.
- 10) **World Culture/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. **Area:** Anthropology 2; Art History 16, 17, 19, 52; English 40; Geography 2; History 6, 16A, 16B, 16C, 19A, 19B, 19C; Political Science 2; Spanish 30B. **Global:** Anthropology 8, 17; English 45; Geography 4; History 2A, 2B; Music 12; Philosophy 14, 15; Political Science 3; Women's Studies 6.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units such as Art Photography 9A, 9B, 43, 46A, 46B; Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 4, 5, 7A, 7B, 31A, 31B, 34A, 34B, 35, 36, 37A, 37B; Dance 58, 59, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 71, 76, 78, 81, 84; English 12B, 12F; Music 1, 2, 15A, 15B, 16, 17A, 17B, 17C, 18A, 18B, 19, 20, 22A, 23, 24A, 24B, 24C, 26A, 26B, 27, 33A, 33B, 34, 35, 36, 38, 40, 51-56, 58-61, 63-75; Theatre Arts 7, 10A, 10B, 10C, 12A, 12B, 13A, 13B, 15, 28, 33, 34, 35.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.
- 13) Consult the SCU Bulletin for additional freshmen and sophomore level requirements in your major. The Bulletin can be found in the web site (www.scu.edu) under Current Students.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Sciences, Liberal Studies (please see following page for specific major guidelines), Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A or 1AH and 1B
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 5A and 5B. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology majors can take Math 12 and 13.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One natural science course with a lab such as Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 3/8A, 4/8A, 10/8A, 11/8A; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 4, 5, 6, 11A, 11B, 11C, 13A/13L; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A/L, 12B/L; Geography 1/L; Geology 10; Meteorology 1/1L; Oceanography 10; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L, 11.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences of such as Art History 20A, 20B; History 4A, 4B; History 4AH, 4BH; Philosophy 6, 7.
- 5) **Biological/Physical Science:** One additional course in science. This second science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Astronomy 10, 11; Environmental Science 10; Physics 10.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 2; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 1H, 2, 3, 5; Psychology 1, 6, 33; Sociology 1, 2, 3, 5.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Anthropology 16; Art History 18; English 24A, 24B, 30A, 30B, 39, 41A, 41B; History 14, 15, 17A, 17AH, 17B, 18A, 18B, 21A, 21B, 23, 29A, 29B; Political Science 1, 1H, 5; Sociology 3.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 6, 17; Communication 12; English 24A, 24B, 39, 41A, 41B; History 14, 18A, 18B, 21A, 21B, 23, 29A, 29B; Sociology 3, 5; Women's Studies 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 13.
- 10) **World Culture/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. **Area:** Anthropology 2; Art History 16, 17, 19, 52; English 40; Geography 2; History 6, 16A, 16B, 16C, 19A, 19B, 19C; Political Science 2; Spanish 30B. **Global:** Anthropology 8, 17; English 45; Geography 4; History 2A, 2B; Music 12; Philosophy 14, 15; Political Science 3; Women's Studies 6.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units such as Art Photography 9A, 9B, 43, 46A, 46B; Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 4, 5, 7A, 7B, 31A, 31B, 34A, 34B, 35, 36, 37A, 37B; Dance 58, 59, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 71, 76, 78, 81, 84; English 12B, 12F; Music 1, 2, 15A, 15B, 16, 17A, 17B, 17C, 18A, 18B, 19, 20, 22A, 23, 24A, 24B, 24C, 26A, 26B, 27, 33A, 33B, 34, 35, 36, 38, 40, 51-56, 58-61, 63-75; Theatre Arts 7, 10A, 10B, 10C, 12A, 12B, 13A, 13B, 15, 28, 33, 34, 35.

- 4) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 5) **Social Science:** Political Science 1 or 1H and Psychology 1.
- 6) **United States:** History 17A or 17AH.
- 7) **World Cultures/Area:** Anthropology 2.
- 8) **World Cultures/Global:** Geography 4.
- 9) **Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units in performing arts such as Dance 58, 59, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 71, 76, 78, 81, 84; English 12B, 12F; Music 1, 2, 15A, 15B, 16, 17A, 17B, 17C, 18A, 18B, 19, 20, 22A, 23, 24A, 24B, 24C, 26A, 26B, 27, 33A, 33B, 34, 35, 36, 38, 40, 51-56, 58-61, 63-75; Theatre Arts 7, 10A, 10B, 10C, 12A, 12B, 13A, 13B, 15, 28, 33, 34, 35.
- 10) **Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are Required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
