Thank you for your interest in Santa Clara University! This guide has been designed to help make the course-planning process easier for students who wish to transfer into the Leavey School of Business at SCU.

Prospective transfer students please note the following prior to using this document:

- This guide represents the core (general education) curriculum Santa Clara University had in place for incoming freshmen students through Fall 2008. As of Fall 2009, SCU introduced a new core curriculum and consequently has designed new guides to assist transfer students with planning. ***Students planning to transfer into SCU for Fall 2010*** as a sophomore or a junior may still utilize the guide found on the following pages. ***Students planning to transfer in Fall 2011 and later*** need to refer to the guide designed for SCU's new core curriculum and should not use the document below for planning purposes.
- Oftentimes schools will cross-list a single course separately under different departments. This guide will individually list cross-listed courses for each department they are found in. It is a student's responsibility to notice whether or not a course is cross-listed as credit will only be issued one time from SCU.
- If a student takes an honors version of a course that is listed on this guide, SCU will accept that class as transferable.
- Math courses eligible for transfer to SCU to fulfill math requirements are listed on this guide. A Pre-Calculus course is eligible to receive general elective credit but will not satisfy SCU's core math requirement.

Bachelor of Science in Commerce

Majors: Accounting, Accounting & Information Systems, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Operations & Management Information Systems.

Admission requirements:

- 1) **English:** Two courses -- *English 100* and *English 110* **OR** *English 165*.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses -- *Math 241* and *242* **or** *Math 251* and *252*.
- 3) **Economics:** *Economics 100* and *102*.
- 4) **Accounting:** *Accounting 121* and *131*.

Recommended courses:

The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) / Leavey School of Business requirements:

- 1) **Business:** *Business 100*.
- 2) **Statistics:** *Math 200* **or** *Economics 123*.
- 3) **Western Culture:** Two courses from **one** of the following sequences: *Art 101, 102, 103; History 100, 101; Humanities 101, 102*.
- 4) **Biological or Physical Science:** One natural science course with a lab from the following: *Astronomy 100/101, 100/103; Biology 110, 210, 220, 230, 240, 250, 260; Chemistry 192, 210, 220, 231, 232, 250; Geology 100/101, 210; Meteorology 100/101; Oceanography 100/101; Paleontology 110/111; Physics 210, 220, 250, 260, 270*.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU (i.e. American Sign Language) to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**

Bachelor of Science in Commerce (continued)

Recommended courses to complete more of SCU's Curriculum / Leavey School of Business requirements:

- 6) **United States:** One course from the following: *English Literature* 201, 202; *Ethnic Studies* 102, 150, 152, 261, 262, 265, 288, 300, 350, 440, 585; *History* 102, 201, 202, 260, 350; *Humanities* 131, 133; *Political Science* 200, 210, 212, 215, 250; *Sociology* 141.
- 7) **World Culture/Societies-Area:** One course from the following: *Anthropology* 110, 370; *Ethnic Studies* 360; *Political Science* 110.
- 8) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology, World Culture/Societies-Global,** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.
- 9) Consult the SCU Bulletin for additional freshmen and sophomore level requirement in your major. The Bulletin can be found in the web site (www.scu.edu) under Current Students.

The above information is to be used as a guide for the purpose of admissions into Santa Clara University. This information is reviewed periodically and the date of the most recent update is noted in the bottom left hand corner of this guide. Students are responsible to make sure that any courses taken are listed on this guide at the time of actual enrollment. Transferability is not guaranteed and is up to our discretion, largely based upon the Santa Clara University core curriculum in effect at the time of admission.
