Majors: Accounting, Accounting & Information Systems, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Operations & Management Information Systems.

The minimum required courses for admissions are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 71 and 72.
- 3) **Economics:** Economics 10A and 10B.
- 4) **Accounting:** Accounting 20 and 21.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 5) **Business:** Business 82
- 6) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences such as Art 91, 92; History 10A, 10B; Music 8A, 8B.
- 7) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Anatomy 1; Anatomy and Physiology 3; Astronomy 10/10L; Biology 1, 2, 3, 20, 21A, 64; Botany 62/L; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 12A, 12B, 15, 30A, 30B, 65; Environmental Science 10; Microbiology 70; Natural Science 10A, 10B; Physical Science 12; Physics 1, 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C.
- 8) **Statistics:** Math 63 or Business 60.
- 9) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take American Sign Language to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete two semesters prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 10) **United States:** One course such as English 60, 62, 80, 82A, 82B, 84A, 84B; History 1, 17A, 17B, 21, 22; Ethnic Studies 11, 28; Music 92; Political Science 1; Social Science 20, 30, 40, 42, 50; Sociology 10, 11.
- 11) **World Cultures/Area:** One course such as Anthropology 63; History 12; Music 90.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.
- 13) Consult the SCU Bulletin for additional freshmen and sophomore level requirements in your major. The Bulletin can be found on the SCU web site (www.scu.edu) under Current Students.

The above information is to be used as a guide for the purpose of admissions into Santa Clara University. This information is reviewed periodically and the date of the most recent update is noted in the bottom left hand corner of this guide. Students are responsible to make sure that any courses taken are listed on this guide at the time of actual enrollment. Transferability is not guaranteed and is up to our discretion, largely based upon the Santa Clara University core curriculum in effect at the time of admission.
