Thank you for your interest in Santa Clara University! This guide has been designed to help make the course-planning process easier for students who wish to transfer into the College of Arts & Sciences at SCU.

Prospective transfer students please note the following prior to using this document:

- This guide represents the core (general education) curriculum Santa Clara University had in place for incoming freshmen students through Fall 2008. As of Fall 2009, SCU introduced a new core curriculum and consequently has designed new guides to assist transfer students with planning. ***Students planning to transfer into SCU for Fall 2010*** as a sophomore or a junior may still utilize the guide found on the following pages. ***Students planning to transfer in Fall 2011 and later*** need to refer to the guide designed for SCU's new core curriculum and should not use the document below for planning purposes.
- Oftentimes schools will cross-list a single course separately under different departments. This guide will individually list cross-listed courses for each department they are found in. It is a student's responsibility to notice whether or not a course is cross-listed as credit will only be issued one time from SCU.
- If a student takes an honors version of a course that is listed on this guide, SCU will accept that class as transferable.
- Math courses eligible for transfer to SCU to fulfill math requirements are listed on this guide. A Pre-Calculus course is eligible to receive general elective credit but will not satisfy SCU's core math requirement.

Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

Admission requirements:

- 1) **English:** Two courses – *English 1A* and *English 1B* **OR** *English 1C*.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course from the following: *Math 1A, 1B, 1C, 10, 11, 12, 44*.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from the following: *Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 10A/10L, 10B/10L; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D/1DL, 10, 13, 14, 15, 40A, 40B, 40C, 41; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C, 12A, 12B, 12C, 25, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 2C, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 10*.

Recommended courses:

The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) requirements:

- 1) **Western Culture:** Three courses from *one* of the following sequences: *Art History 2A, 2B, 2C, History 4A, 4B, 4C; Music 2A, 2B, 2C; Philosophy 20A, 20B, 20C*.
- 2) **Math or Science:** One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: *Anthropology 1; Astronomy 10A, 10B; Biology 1D, 9, 12, 45; Physics 6, 12*
- 3) **Modern Languages:** Bachelor of Arts students must successfully complete the third quarter course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU (i.e. American Sign Language) to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 4) **Social Science:** One course from the following: *Anthropology 2A, 3, 8; Economics 1A, 1B, Political Science 1, 2, 15; Psychology 1, 10, 30; Sociology 1, 10, 20, 30*.
- 5) **United States:** One course from the following: *Art 14; Communication 10, 12; English 7, 12, 31, 40, 41, 48A, 48B, 48C; Fine Arts 1, 2; History 17A, 17B, 17C; Music 8; Photography 8, Political Science 1; Sociology 8, 23; Theatre Arts 8; Video Arts 3*.
- 6) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course from the following: *Art 2E; Communication 10, 12; English 5, 7, 12, 22, 31, 40, 41; History 10; Music 8; Photography 8; Psychology 21; Sociology 21, 23; Women's Studies 5, 11, 15, 21*.

Bachelor of Arts Degree (continued)

Recommended courses to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum requirements:

Global: *Anthropology 3; Business 53; Economics 25; Geography 2, 5, 10. Music 2D; Philosophy 22; Political Science 15; Women's Studies 11.*

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Economics, Engineering, Physics, Environmental Studies, Liberal Studies (pre-teaching), Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Public Health Science, Psychology and Sociology.
Please note: *Students interested in majoring in Liberal Studies, Biology or Public Health Science should refer to major-specific guides on the following pages.*

Admission requirements:

- 1) **English:** Two courses – *English 1A* and *English 1B* **OR** *English 1C*.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses: *Math 1A* and *1B*. Political Science majors can choose to take two courses from *Math 1A, 1B, 10, 11, and 12*. Psychology majors can choose to take *Math 1A* and *1B* **OR** *Math 11* and *12*. Sociology, Anthropology, and Liberal Studies majors can choose two courses from *1A, 1B, 10, 11, 12, 44*.
Please note: a) *Students may not take Math 12 in conjunction with Math 1A or 1B;*
b) *Anthropology majors will need Math 10 for their major at SCU.*
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from the following: *Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 10A/10L, 10B/10L; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D/1DL, 10, 13, 14, 15, 40A, 40B, 40C, 41; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C, 12A, 12B, 12C, 25, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 2C, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 10.*

Recommended courses:

The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) requirements:

- 1) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: *Art History 2A, 2B, 2C, History 4A, 4B, 4C; Music 2A, 2B, 2C; Philosophy 20A, 20B, 20C.*
- 2) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: *Anthropology 1; Astronomy 10A, 10B; Biology 1D, 9, 12, 45; Physics 6, 12*
- 3) **Modern Languages:** Bachelor of Arts students must successfully complete the third quarter course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 4) **Social Science:** One course from the following: *Anthropology 2A, 3, 8; Economics 1A, 1B, Political Science 1, 2, 15; Psychology 1, 10, 30; Sociology 1, 10, 20, 30.*

- 7) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from Area and Global Lists.

Bachelor of Science Degree – Liberal Studies

Admission requirements:

- 1) **English:** Two courses – *English 1A* and *English 1B* **OR** *English 1C*.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses from the following: *Math 1A*, *1B*, *10*, *11*, *12*, *44*.

Please note: a) *The Liberal Studies Department recommends that students choose Math 10 as one of their math selections in order to better prepare them for their major coursework at SCU;*
b) *Students may not take Math 12 in conjunction with Math 1A or 1B.*

Recommended courses:

The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) / Liberal Studies requirements:

- 1) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: *Art History 2A, 2B, 2C; History 4A, 4B, 4C; Music 2A, 2B, 2C; Philosophy 20A, 20B, 20C*.
- 2) **Modern Languages:** Bachelor of Social Science students must successfully complete the third quarter course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU (i.e. American Sign Language) to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 3) **Social Science:** *Political Science 1* and *Psychology 1*.
- 4) **United States:** *History 17A* or *17B*
- 5) **World Cultures/Area:** *Anthropology 2A*
- 6) **World Cultures/Global:** *Geography 10*
- 7) **Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling a minimum of four quarter units in Performing Arts only from the following: *Dance 1A, 1B, 2, 3A, 3B, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9; Music 3A, 3B, 3C, 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 12D, 12E, 13A, 13B, 13C, 14A, 14B, 14C, 15A, 15B, 15C; Music Performance* -- any class from course numbers 19 through 40Z only; *Theatre Arts 20A, 20B, 20C, 20D, 20E, 24, 46*.
- 8) **Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree – Biology or Public Health Science

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** Two courses – *English 1A* and *English 1B* **OR** *English 1C*.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses -- *Math 1A* and *1B*.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from the following: *Chemistry 1A, 1B*.

Recommended courses:

The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) / Biology or Public Health Science requirements:

- 1) **Statistics:** *Math 10* for Public Health Science majors only.
- 2) **Biological Sciences:** *Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D/1DL*.
- 3) **Chemistry:** *Chemistry 1B, 1C, 12A, 12B, 12C*. **Public Health Science majors please note:** It is only necessary to complete through *Chemistry 12B* to satisfy major requirements. If interested in a Pre-Med track, students will need to complete *Chemistry 12C*.
- 4) **Physics:** *Physics 2A, 2B, 2C or 4A, 4B, 4C* for Biology and those Public Health Science majors interested in pursuing a Pre-Med track only.

****Note: It is recommended that you take the introductory Biology or general Chemistry sequence courses prior to taking the Physics series.**

- 5) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: *Art History 2A, 2B, 2C; History 4A, 4B, 4C; Music 2A, 2B, 2C; Philosophy 20A, 20B, 20C*.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Bachelor of Natural Science students must successfully complete the second quarter course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 7) **Social Science:** One course from the following: *Anthropology 2A, 3, 8; Economics 1A, 1B, Political Science 1, 2, 15; Psychology 1, 10, 30; Sociology 1, 10, 20, 30*.
- 8) **United States:** One course from the following: *Art 14; Communication 10, 12; English 7, 12, 31, 40, 41, 48A, 48B, 48C; Fine Arts 1, 2; History 17A, 17B, 17C; Music 8; Photography 8, Political Science 1; Sociology 8, 23; Theatre Arts 8; Video Arts 3*.
