

Mission College Transfer Guide

COLLEGE OF ART & SCIENCES

Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 3A, 3B, 8, or 10.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Anthropology 1 with 1L; **Astronomy 1 with 2;** Biological Science 1A, 1B, 4, 5, 10, 16, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B; Music 1, 2.
- 5) **Math or Science: One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are:** Anthropology 1, Biology 8, 15, 25.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3; Economics 1A, 1B; Global Studies 1, 2, 3 (also listed as Social Science 1, 2, 3); Philosophy 5; Political Science 1, 2, 4; Psychology 1; Sociology 1, 2, 21, 24, 41, 43, 46.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 14, 18, 45; History 3, 17A, 17B; Humanities 18; Political Science 1, 2, 6; Sociology 2, 21, 38, 41, 50.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 57; Art 1C; Communication 12; English 12, 14, 18; History 3, 20, 33; Humanities 16A, 18; Political Science 6; Sociology 21, 41, 46.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. You *may not* transfer in two courses classified as Global to fulfill this requirement. **Area:** Anthropology 3; Art 7; History 6, 18, 30, 31; Humanities 20, 22; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2. **Global:** Anthropology 51; English 6A, 6B; Geography 2; Global 4, 6; Music 17; Philosophy 4; Political Science 4, 7 (also listed as Humanities 7); Social Science 1 (also listed as Global Studies 1), 6 (also listed as Global Studies 6).
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 31A, 31B, 33A, 33B, 33C, 35A, 35B, 35C, 35D, 39A, 47A, 47B, 47C, 47D, 49A, 49B, 49C, 49D, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 67A, 67B, 67C, 67D, 85A, 85B, 85C, 85D; English 70; Music 5, 5A, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 36A, 36B, 36C, 36D, 39A, 39B, 39C, 39D, 41A, 41B, 41C, 41D, 48A, 48B, 48C, 48D, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 66A; P.E. 3B-3N, 3P, 3R-3Z.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Studies, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 3A and 3B. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology majors can take Math 8 and 10.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Anthropology 1 with 1L; Astronomy 1 with 2; Biological Science 1A, 1B, 4, 5, 10, 16, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B; Music 001, 002.
- 5) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course in science. This second science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Anthropology 1, Biology 8, 15, 25.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3; Economics 1A, 1B; Global Studies 1, 2, 3 (also listed as Social Science 1, 2, 3); Philosophy 5; Political Science 1, 2, 4; Psychology 1; Sociology 1, 2, 21, 24, 41, 43, 46.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 14, 18, 45; History 3, 17A, 17B; Humanities 18; Political Science 1, 2, 6; Sociology 2, 21, 38, 41, 50.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 57; Art 1C; Communication 12; English 12, 14, 18; History 3, 20, 33; Humanities 16A, 18; Political Science 6; Sociology 21, 41, 46.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. You *may not* transfer in two courses classified as Global to fulfill this requirement. **Area:** Anthropology 3; Art 7; History 6, 18, 30, 31; Humanities 20, 22; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2. **Global:** Anthropology 51; English 6A, 6B; Geography 2; Global 4, 6; Music 17; Philosophy 4; Political Science 4, 7 (also listed as Humanities 7); Social Science 1 (also listed as Global Studies 1), 6 (also listed as Global Studies 6).
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 31A, 31B, 33A, 33B, 33C, 35A, 35B, 35C, 35D, 39A, 47A, 47B, 47C, 47D, 49A, 49B, 49C, 49D, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 67A, 67B, 67C, 67D, 85A, 85B, 85C, 85D; English 70; Music 5, 5A, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 36A, 36B, 36C, 36D, 39A, 39B, 39C, 39D, 41A, 41B, 41C, 41D, 48A, 48B, 48C, 48D, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 66A; P.E. 3B-3N, 3P, 3R-3Z.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science – Liberal Studies

- 3) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B; Music 001, 002.
- 4) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement.
- 5) **Social Science:** Political Science 1 and Psychology 1.
- 6) **United States:** History 17A.
- 7) **World Cultures/Area:** Anthropology 3.
- 8) **Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses only within Performing Arts totaling three semester units, such as Music 5, 5A, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 36A, 36B, 36C, 36D, 39A, 39B, 39C, 39D, 41A, 41B, 41C, 41D, 48A, 48B, 48C, 48D, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 66A; P.E. 3B-3N, 3P, 3R-3Z.
- 9) **Biological/Physical Science without a Lab, Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies, Studio/Performing Arts, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
