

Mission College Transfer Guide

Majors: Accounting, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Operations and Management Information Systems.

The minimum required courses for admissions are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 3A and 3B.
- 3) **Economics:** Economics 1A and 1B.
- 4) **Accounting:** Accounting 1A and 1B.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 5) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences such as Art 1A, 1B; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B; Music 001, 002.
- 6) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Anthropology 1 with 1L; Astronomy 1 with 2; Biological Science 1A, 1B, 4, 5, 10, 16, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.
- 7) **Statistics:** Math 10.
- 8) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement.
- 9) **United States:** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 14, 18, 45; History 3, 17A, 17B; Humanities 18; Political Science 1, 2, 6; Sociology 2, 21, 38, 41, 50..
- 10) **World Culture/Societies:** One area studies course such as Anthropology 3; Art 7; History 6, 18, 30, 31; Humanities 20, 22; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
- 12) Consult the SCU Bulletin for additional freshmen and sophomore level requirement in your major. The Bulletin can be found in the web site (www.scu.edu) under Current Students.

The above information is to be used as a guide for the purpose of admissions into Santa Clara University. This information is reviewed periodically and the date of the most recent update is noted in the bottom left hand corner of this guide. Students are responsible to make sure that any courses taken are listed on this guide at the time of actual enrollment.
