

# West Valley College Articulation Guide

## COLLEGE OF ART & SCIENCES

### Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

### The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 8, 10, 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, or 4C.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One **lab** science course such as Astronomy 1 with 2, 10/10L, 11/11L; Biology 10 with 10L, 11, 12, 18, 22, 41, 42, 43, 45, 46, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Geology 1A, 1B/2B, 10A; Ocean 10; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.

### Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B, 1D; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B.
- 5) **Math or Science:** One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Anthropology 1; Astronomy 14; Biology 24; Geology 10, 15; Oceanography 1.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first- year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 2, 4; Psychology 1, 7; Sociology 1, 2, 3, 20, 45.
- 8) **United States :** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 13, 18, 46; History 3, 12, 14, 16, 17A, 17B; Music 54; Philosophy 16; Political Science 1, 5; Sociology 20.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 4; Communication 12; English 12, 13, 18, 46; History 3, 12, 14, 16; Philosophy 21; Psychology 9; Political Science 5; Sociology 20; Women's Studies 1, 2.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. **Area:** Anthropology 3; Art 7, 12A, 12B; English 16; History 8B, 11, 30A, 30B; Humanities 5; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2. **Global:** History 5A, 5B, 8A; Geography 2; Philosophy 4; Political Science 4.
- 11) **Fine Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 31A, 31B, 31C, 33A, 33C, 35A, 35B, 35C, 35D, 36, 40A, 40B, 40C, 40D, 41A, 41B, 41C, 41D, 47A, 47B, 47C, 47D, 49A, 49B, 49C, 49D, 52, 54, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 67A, 67B, 85A, 85B; Music 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, 26, 27, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 34, 36, 41, 42, 43A, 43B, 48, 49, 51, 53, 61, 62A; Photography 1/1L, 2/2L, 20A, 20B, 30; Physical Education 3.01-3.35; Theatre Arts 7A, 7B, 7C, 33A, 33B, 35A, 40A, 40B, 41A, 41B.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.

## Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Sciences, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

### The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 3A and 3B. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology and/or Sociology majors can take Math 8 and 10.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One **lab** science course such as Astronomy 1 with 2, 10/10L, 11/11L; Biology 10 with 10L, 11, 12, 18, 22, 41, 42, 43, 45, 46, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Geology 1A, 1B/2B, 10A; Ocean 10; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.

### Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B, 1D; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B.
- 5) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course in science. This second science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Anthropology 1; Astronomy 14; Biology 24; Geology 10, 15; Oceanography 1.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 2, 4; Psychology 1, 7; Sociology 1, 2, 3, 20, 45.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 13, 18, 46; History 3, 12, 14, 16, 17A, 17B; Music 54; Philosophy 16; Political Science 1, 5; Sociology 20.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 4; Communication 12; English 12, 13, 18, 46; History 3, 12, 14, 16; Philosophy 21; Psychology 9; Political Science 5; Sociology 20; Women's Studies 1, 2.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. **Area:** Anthropology 3; Art 7, 12A, 12B; English 16; History 8B, 11, 30A, 30B; Humanities 5; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2. **Global:** History 5A, 5B, 8A; Geography 2; Philosophy 4; Political Science 4.
- 11) **Fine Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 31A, 31B, 31C, 33A, 33C, 35A, 35B, 35C, 35D, 36, 40A, 40B, 40C, 40D, 41A, 41B, 41C, 41D, 47A, 47B, 47C, 47D, 49A, 49B, 49C, 49D, 52, 54, 65A, 65B, 65C, 65D, 67A, 67B, 85A, 85B; Music 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, 26, 27, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 34, 36, 41, 42, 43A, 43B, 48, 49, 51, 53, 61, 62A; Photography 1/1L, 2/2L, 20A, 20B, 30; Physical Education 3.01-3.35; Theatre Arts 7A, 7B, 7C, 33A, 33B, 35A, 40A, 40B, 41A, 41B.

- 5) **Social Science:** Political Science 1 and Psychology 1.
- 6) **United States:** History 17A.
- 7) **World Culture/Area:** Anthropology 3.
- 8) **Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses in Performing Arts only totaling three semester units, such as Music 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, 26, 27, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 34, 36, 41, 42, 43A, 43B, 48, 49, 51, 53, 61, 62A; Music 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, 26, 27, 30A, 30B, 31A, 31B, 32A, 32B, 33A, 33B, 34, 36, 41, 42, 43A, 43B, 48, 49, 51, 53, 61, 62A; Physical Education 3.01-3.35; Theatre Arts 7A, 7B, 7C, 33A, 33B, 35A, 40A, 40B, 41A, 41B.
- 9) **Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.
