Majors: Accounting, Accounting & Information Systems, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Operations & Management Information Systems.

The minimum required courses for admissions are :

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 3A and 3B.
- 3) **Economics:** Economics 1A and 1B.
- 4) **Accounting:** Accounting 10 and 11.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 5) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences such as Art 1A, 1B; History 4A, 4B; Humanities 1A, 1B.
- 6) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Astronomy 1 with 2, 10 with 10L, 11 with 11L; Biology 10 with 10L, 11, 12, 18, 22, 41, 42, 43, 45, 46, 47, 48; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A, 12B, 30A, 30B; Geology 1A, 1B with 2B, 10A; Ocean 10; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10.
- 7) **Business Computing:** CIS 2
- 8) **Statistics:** Math 10.
- 9) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year sequence in a classical or modern foreign or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 10) **United States:** One course such as Art 10; English 7A, 7B, 12, 13, 18, 46; History 3, 12, 14, 16, 17A, 17B; Music 54; Philosophy 16; Political Science 1, 5; Sociology 20.
- 11) **World Cultures/Area:** One course such as Anthropology 3; Art 7, 12A, 12B; English 16; History 8B, 11, 30A, 30B; Humanities 5; Philosophy 8; Political Science 2.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.
- 13) Consult the SCU Bulletin for additional freshmen and sophomore level requirements in your major. The Bulletin can be found in the web site (www.scu.edu) under Current Students.

The above information is to be used as a guide for the purpose of admissions into Santa Clara University. This information is reviewed periodically and the date of the most recent update is noted in the bottom left hand corner of this guide. Students are responsible to make sure that any courses taken are listed on this guide at the time of actual enrollment.
