### COLLEGE OF ART & SCIENCES

#### **Bachelor of Arts Degree**

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

#### **The minimum required courses for admission are:**

- 1) **English:** English Writing 300 and 301.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 344, 400, 401, or Statistics 301.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Anthropology 300/301; Astronomy 300/400; Biology 303, 305, 310, 320, 332, 370, 400, 410, 420, 430, 431, 440, 442; Chemistry 305, 306, 310, 320, 400, 401, 420, 421, 423, 430; Geography 300/301, 308/309; Geology 300/301, 305/306, 310/311, 330/331; Physics 305, 310/312, 350, 360, 410, 421, 431.

#### **Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:**

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art History 302, 308, 310; History 300, 302; Humanities 300, 310; Philosophy 330, 331.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or a modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 310, 320, 333; Political Science 301; Psychology 300, 320; Sociology 300.
- 7) **United States:** One course such as English Literature 320, 321, 333, 334; History 310, 311, 318, 320, 321, 323, 325, 327, 330; Political Science 301; Sociology 301, 320, 325, 342.
- 8) **Multicultural:** One course such as Anthropology 330, 333; Art History 334; English Literature 333, 334, 337, 360; History 305, 320, 321, 323, 325, 327, 330, 367; Sociology 325, 342; Theatre Arts 318.
- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 310, 315; History 364, 365, 373; Humanities 320; Philosophy 353.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be fulfilled by a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 300, 302, 304, 305, 320, 322, 323, 327, 328, 329, 336, 337, 361, 370, 372, 373, 375, 390, 391, 411, 412, 413; Music Fundamentals/History and Literature 310, 311; Instrumental/Voice Instruction 320, 321, 340, 350, 351, 370, 371, 385, 386, 430, 431, 440, 442, 444, 446; Dance 302, 310, 320, 330, 360; Theatre Arts 350, 350, 351, 356, 357, 360, 362, 366, 370, 375.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.

## Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Sciences, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Anthropology 300/301; Astronomy 300/400; Biology 303, 305, 310, 320, 332, 370, 400, 410, 420, 430, 431, 440, 442; Chemistry 305, 306, 310, 320, 400, 401, 420, 421, 423, 430; Geography 300/301, 308/309; Geology 300/301, 305/306, 310/311, 330/331; Physics 305, 310/312, 350, 360, 410, 421, 431.

- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 310, 315; History 364, 365, 373; Humanities 320; Philosophy 353.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be fulfilled by a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 300, 302, 304, 305, 320, 322, 323, 327, 328, 329, 336, 337, 361, 370, 372, 373, 375, 390, 391, 411, 412, 413; Music Fundamentals/History and Literature 310, 311; Instrumental/Voice Instruction 320, 321, 340, 350, 351, 370, 371, 385, 386, 430, 431, 440, 442, 444, 446; Dance 302, 310, 320, 330, 360; Theatre Arts 350, 350, 351, 356, 357, 360, 362, 366, 370, 375.
