Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 100 and 110.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 125, 200, 251, or 252.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Astronomy 100/101; Biology 110, 130, 225, 230, 240, 250, 260; Chemistry 112, 192, 210, 220; Geology 100; Physics 210, 220, 250, 260, 270.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 101, 102, 103; History 100, 101; Literature 142, 143; Philosophy 160, 175, 190; Drama 142, 143.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 110, 350; Economics 102; Political Science 103, 130, 150, 210; Psychology 100, 300, 410; Sociology 100, 105.
- 7) **U. S. History:** One course such as Economics 230, History 102, 201, 202, 205; Literature 200, 266, 370; Political Science 210.
- 8) **Multicultural:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 108, 360; History 242, 245, 246, 247; Literature 251, 252, 266, 370, 371, 372, 373, 375; Psychology 106; Social Science 250; Sociology 141, 254.
- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 110, 370; History 422, 425, 451, 452; Philosophy 320.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 201, 202, 204, 205, 206, 207, 214, 221, 222, 229, 231, 232, 301, 303, 351; Drama 200, 201, 202, 203; Music 100, 301, 302, 303, 304, 371, 372, 373, 374, 450, 461, 462, 463, 464, 476, 486.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Studies, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 100 and 110.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 251 and 252. Sociology/Anthropology/Political Science majors can take Math 125 and 200.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Astronomy 100/101; Biology 110, 130, 225, 230, 240, 250, 260; Chemistry 112, 192, 210, 220; Geology 100; Physics 210, 220, 250, 260, 270.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences of such as Art 101, 102, 103; History 100, 101; Literature 142, 143; Philosophy 160, 175, 190; Drama 142, 143.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students in the Natural Science and Mathematics must successfully complete the second course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. Students in Social Sciences must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 110, 350; Economics 102; Political Science 103, 130, 150, 210; Psychology 100, 300, 410; Sociology 100, 105.
- 7) **U.S. History:** One course such as Economics 230, History 102, 201, 202, 205; Literature 200, 266, 370; Political Science 210.
- 8) **Multicultural:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 108, 360; History 242, 245, 246, 247; Literature 251, 252, 266, 370, 371, 372, 373, 375; Psychology 106; Social Science 250; Sociology 141, 254.
- 9) **World Culture/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 105, 110, 370; History 422, 425, 451, 452; Philosophy 320.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 201, 202, 204, 205, 206, 207, 214, 221, 222, 229, 231, 232, 301, 303, 351; Drama 200, 201, 202, 203; Music 100, 301, 302, 303, 304, 371, 372, 373, 374, 450, 461, 462, 463, 464, 476, 486.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

- 9) **Biological or Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies, Studio/Performing Arts, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology,** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
