Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 4.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 1, 2, 33, 43.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Anatomy 1; Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 1/30L, 10/30L, 20/30L; Biology 1, 2A, 2B; Botany 1; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 5, 12A, 12B; Geography 1/1L; Geology 10/10L, 12/12L; Microbiology 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L; Physiology 1; Zoology 1.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 4, 5; History 1, 2.
- 5) **Mathematical & Sciences:** One additional course in either subject.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3, 5; Economics 1; Political Science 1, 2, 7, 20, 25, 30, 40; Psychology 1, 3; Sociology 1, 2.
- 8) **U. S. History:** One course such as Anthropology 5; Economics 5, 12; English 22, 30, 32; History 7, 8, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 25, 27, 28; Political Science 7, 40; Sociology 2.
- 9) **Multicultural:** One course such as Anthropology 5, 8, 12; English 21, 22, 23, 32, 33, 48; History 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 25, 27; Psychology 18; Sociology 3, 4, 10.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 3; History 19; Political Science 20; Religious Studies 11, 30.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 7A, 7B, 7C, 7D, 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 12D, 13A, 13B, 13C, 13D, 16A, 16B, 16C, 16D, 17; Dance 1; Music 8A, 8B, 20, 21A, 21B, 23A, 23B; Photography 50, Theater 1A, 1B.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 4.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 1 and 2. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology majors can take Math 33 and 43.
- 4) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Anatomy 1; Anthropology 1/1L; Astronomy 1/30L, 10/30L, 20/30L; Biology 1, 2A, 2B; Botany 1; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 5, 12A, 12B; Geography 1/1L; Geology 10/10L, 12/12L; Microbiology 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L; Physiology 1;
- 3) Zoology 1.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences of such as Art 4, 5; History 1, 2.
- 5) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course in each subject.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3, 5; Economics 1; Political Science 1, 2, 7, 20, 25, 30, 40; Psychology 1, 3; Sociology 1, 2.
- 8) **U. S. History:** One course such as Anthropology 5; Economics 5, 12; English 22, 30, 32; History 7, 8, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 25, 27, 28; Political Science 7, 40; Sociology 2.
- 9) **Multicultural:** One course such as Anthropology 5, 8, 12; English 21, 22, 23, 32, 33, 48; History 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 25, 27; Psychology 18; Sociology 3, 4, 10.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 3; History 19; Political Science 20; Religious Studies 11, 30.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 7A, 7B, 7C, 7D, 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 12D, 13A, 13B, 13C, 13D, 16A, 16B, 16C, 16D, 17; Dance 1; Music 8A, 8B, 20, 21A, 21B, 23A, 23B; Photography 50, Theater 1A, 1B.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

- 6) **Social Science:** Political Science 7 and Psychology 1.
- 7) **United States:** History 7 and 8.
- 8) **World Cultures/Global:** Geography 2.
- 9) Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies , Studio/Performing Arts, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology and a third course in English Composition are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
