COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Classics, Communication, English, History, Liberal Studies (Pre-Teaching), Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Theatre and Dance.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 122 and 123.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 142, 181, 192, 193.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science with a lab:** One course from the following list: Anthropology 140/141L; Biological Science 102, 117, 119, 120, 126, 130, 131, 139, 140, 146, 160, 205; Chemistry 108, 109, 120, 121, 226, 227; Geography 120/121, 140/141; Geology 120/122, 121/124; Oceanography 109/110; Physics 110/111, 120, 121, 129, 130, 230, 231.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** You may fulfill this requirement in two ways: a) Take **two** courses from *one* of the following sequences: History 140, 141; Philosophy 224, 225; b) Take **three** courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art History 195, 196, 197; Humanities 110, 111, 112.
- 5) **Math/Sciences:** One additional course in either subject. The second science course may be taken from section three above or from the following list: Anthropology 115, 140; Biological Science 101, 116, 170; Geography 120, 140; Geology 120, 121; Oceanography 109; Physical Science 112; Physics 110.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 125, 130, 140; Economics 220, 221; English 124; Political Science 120, 121, 220, 250; Psychology 122, 130, 210, 220, 230; Sociology 120, 121, 122, 124, 140; Social Science 110.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Anthropology 135; Drama 142; English 163, 164, 166, 168, 262, 263; Film 140, 160, 280, 282; History 120, 121, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129, 130, 170, 171; Humanities 115, 120, 123; Music Literature 112, 116; Political Science 121; Psychology 140, 140; Social Science 110, 111, 115, 120, 123, 220; Sociology 131, 135.
- 9) **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 120, 135; English 162, 163, 164, 166, 167, 168, 173, 190; Film 160, 284; History 124, 125, 127, 128, 129, 130, 170, 171; Humanities 115, 120; Music Literature 112, 116; Psychology 140, 141, 150; Social Science 115, 120, 220; Sociology 124, 125, 131, 135.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area list or one each from the Area and Global lists. You *may not* transfer in two courses classified as Global to fulfill this requirement.
Area: Anthropology 130, 150; Art History 193, 194; English 167; History 135, 136, 150, 151; Humanities 116; Music Literature 115; Political Science 220.
Global: English 170; Geography 130; Music Literature 114; Political Science 250.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** Three semester units in Studio/Performing Arts or Music such as Art 105, 105A, 105B, 106, 106A, 106B, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 120, 120A, 120B, 121, 126, 126A, 126B, 127, 129, 140, 141, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 160, 161; Drama 110, 111, 112, 113, 118, 122, 123, 124, 126, 170; Music 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 150, 151, 152, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 170, 171, 250, 252, 255, 260, 261.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but must be taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 192 and 193. Social Science majors can take Math 142 and 181.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science with a lab:** One course from the following list: Anthropology 140/141L; Biological Science 102, 117, 119, 120, 126, 130, 131, 139, 140, 146, 160, 205; Chemistry 108, 109, 120, 121, 226, 227; Geography 120/121, 140/141; Geology 120/122, 121/124; Oceanography 109/110; Physics 110/111, 120, 121, 129, 130, 230, 231.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art History 195, 196, 197; History 140, 141; Humanities 110, 111, 112; Philosophy 224, 225.
- 5) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course. The second science course can be taken from section three above or from the following list: Anthropology 115, 140; Biological Science 101, 116, 170; Geography 120, 140; Geology 120, 121; Oceanography 109; Physical Science 112; Physics 110.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students in Natural Sciences and Mathematics must successfully complete the second course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. Students in Social Sciences must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 125, 130, 140; Economics 220, 221; English 124; Political Science 120, 121, 220, 250; Psychology 122, 130, 210, 220, 230; Sociology 120, 121, 122, 124, 140; Social Science 110.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Anthropology 135; Drama 142; English 163, 164, 166, 168, 262, 263; Film 140, 160, 280, 282; History 120, 121, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129, 130, 170, 171; Humanities 115, 120, 123; Music Literature 112, 116; Political Science 121; Psychology 140, 140; Social Science 110, 111, 115, 120, 123, 220; Sociology 131, 135.
- 9) **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 120, 135; English 162, 163, 164, 166, 167, 168, 173, 190; Film 160, 284; History 124, 125, 127, 128, 129, 130, 170, 171; Humanities 115, 120; Music Literature 112, 116; Psychology 140, 141, 150; Social Science 115, 120, 220; Sociology 124, 125, 131, 135.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area list or one each from the Area and Global lists. You *may not* transfer in two courses classified as Global to fulfill this requirement.

Global: English 170; Geography 130; Music Literature 114; Political Science 250.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** Three semester units in Studio/Performing Arts or Music such as Art 105, 105A, 105B, 106, 106A, 106B, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 120, 120A, 120B, 121, 126, 126A, 126B, 127, 129, 140, 141, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 160, 161; Drama 110, 111, 112, 113, 118, 122, 123, 124, 126, 170; Music 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 150, 151, 152, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 170, 171, 250, 252, 255, 260, 261.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but must be taken at Santa Clara University.

- 7) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology, Ethnic/Women's Studies, World Cultures/Societies, Studio/Performing Arts,** and a third course in **English Composition** are required, but taken at Santa Clara University.
