

Gavilan College Transfer Guide

College of Arts & Sciences

Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Classics, Communication, English, History, Liberal Studies (Pre-Teaching), Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Theatre and Dance.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

1. **English:** English 1A & 1B
2. **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 5, 7 or 1A, 1B.
3. **Biological or Physical Science:** select one course from the following: Biology 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 15, 20; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Geology 1; or Physics 1, 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

1. **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B or History 7A, 7B.
2. **Mathematical & Sciences:** One additional course in either subject.
3. **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
4. **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 3; Economics *1, 2; Political Science 1, 3; Psychology 1A, 1B; or Sociology 1A, 1B, 3, 4.
5. **United States:** One course such as English 2H, 2I, 5A, 5B; Humanities 4; History *1, 2, 5, 12, 18, 19; Political Science 1.
6. **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as English 2B, 2E, 2H, 2I; History 5, 12; Sociology 3, 4; Art 20; Philosophy 6; Theater 3.
7. **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Geography 2; Art 20; Anthropology 3.
8. **Studio/Performing Arts or Music:** Three semester units such as Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 8A, 9A, 10B, 12A, 15A, 16A; Music 4A, 4B, 8A, 8B, 9A, 9B; Theater Art 12A.
9. Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology and a third course in English Composition are required, but taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Mathematics and Computer Science, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

1. **English:** English 1A and 1B.
2. **Mathematics:** Math 1A, 1B. Sociology/Anthropology majors can take Math 5, 7.
3. **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 15, 20; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Geology 1; or Physics 1, 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

1. **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 1A, 1B *or* History 7A, 7B.
2. **Math and Science:** One additional course in each subject.
3. **Modern Languages:** Students in the Natural Sciences and Mathematics must successfully complete the second course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. Students in Social Sciences must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
4. **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 3; Economics *1, 2; Political Science 1, 3; Psychology 1A, 1B; or Sociology 1A, 1B, 3, 4.
5. **United States:** One course such as English 2H, 2I, 5A, 5B; Humanities 4; History *1, 2, 5, 12, 18, 19; Political Science 1.
6. **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as English 2B, 2E, 2H, 2I; History 5, 12; Sociology 3, 4; Art 20; Philosophy 6; Theater 3.
7. **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Geography 2; Art 20; Anthropology 3.
8. **Studio/Performing Arts or Music:** Three semester units such as Art 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 8A, 9A, 10B, 12A, 15A, 16A; Music 4A, 4B, 8A, 8B, 9A, 9B; Theater Art 12A.
9. Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology and a third course in English Composition are required, but taken at Santa Clara University.
