Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 2, 3A, 3B, 13, or 16.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 1, 2, 3, 5, 6/61, 7, 10, 20, 27, 37, 42, 47; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 12A, 12B, 22; Geology 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art History 1A, 1B; English 44A, 44B; History 4A, 4B; Philosophy 6, 8.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3; Economics 5; Political Science 1, 2; Psychology 1A, 1B; Sociology 1, 5, 41.
- 7) **United States:** One course such as English 25, 26, 27, 47A, 47B; Ethnic Studies 3, 4, 5; History 17A, 17B, 40, 46, 48, 49A, 49B; Music 5; Political Science 1, 2, 5.
- 8) **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 10, 15; Art 25; English 25, 26, 27; Ethnic Studies 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 25; History 40, 46, 47, 48, 49A, 49B, 51; Music 1C, 5; Sociology 42.
- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 20; Art 1D, History 41.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 3, 4, 5, 6A, 6B, 6C, 8, 11A, 11B, 12A, 12B, 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B, 15C, 16; Dance 100, 101, 102, 110, 120, 130, 131, 132, 133; Music 10, 11, 12, 13A, 13B, 14, 15, 16, 17A, 17B, 17C, 17D, 20, 21, 22, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 50A, 50B; Photography 1, 2; Theatre Arts 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 30A, 30B.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Studies, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 3A and 3B. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology majors can take Math 13 and 16.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 1, 2, 3, 5, 6/6I, 7, 10, 20, 27, 37, 42, 47; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 12A, 12B, 22; Geology 1; Physics 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences, such as Art History 1A, 1B; English 44A, 44B; History 4A, 4B; Philosophy 6, 8.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.

- 8) **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 10, 15; Art 25; English 25, 26, 27; Ethnic Studies 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 25; History 40, 46, 47, 48, 49A, 49B, 51; Music 1C, 5; Sociology 42.
- 9) **World Culture/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 20; Art 1D, History 41.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts or Music:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 3, 4, 5, 6A, 6B, 6C, 8, 11A, 11B, 12A, 12B, 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B, 15C, 16; Dance 100, 101, 102, 110, 120, 130, 131, 132, 133; Music 10, 11, 12, 13A, 13B, 14, 15, 16, 17A, 17B, 17C, 17D, 20, 21, 22, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 50A, 50B; Photography 1, 2; Theatre Arts 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 30A, 30B.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
