

# Laney College Articulation Guide

## College of Arts and Sciences

### Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Classics, Communication, English, History, Liberal Studies (Pre-Teaching), Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Theatre and Dance.

#### The minimum required courses for admission are:

1. **English:** English 1A & 1B.
2. **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 3A, 3B, 13.
3. **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 1A-B, 2, 3, 4, 10, 12A, 20A-B; Chemistry 1A-B, 12A-B; Physics 2A-B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

1. **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: \*Art 2, 3, 4; History 2A-B; Humanities 31A-B, Philosophy 20A-B.
2. **Mathematical & Sciences:** One additional course in either subject.
3. **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
4. **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3, 7; Economics \*1, 2; Political Science 1, 2, 3, 4; Psychology \*1A-B; Sociology 1, 2.
5. **United States:** One course such as African American Studies 1, 5, 29, 30, 31, 32; Asian American Studies 21; English 30A-B, 230A-B; History \*7A, 7B, 17, 32; Music 15A, 15B; Political Science 1.
6. **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as African American Studies 1, 5, 8, 9, 11, 12, 17, 30, 31, 32; Asian American Studies 17, 2145A, 45B; English 31, 32A-B; Mexican American Studies 12, 17, 23; Native American Studies 17; Sociology 5.
7. **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Art 5, 6; Asian American Studies 26, 29, 30; Geography 2; History 5; Political Science 3.
8. **Fine Arts:** Three semester units in Studio/Performing Arts or Music such as Art 20, 21, 22, 23, 41, 42, 50, 51, 70, 71, 80, 81, 52; Music 3A-B, 35A-B, 38A-B; Photography 10; Theater Arts 10A-B, 11A-B.
9. Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology and a third course in English Composition are required, but taken at Santa Clara University.

## Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

1. **English:** English 1A & 1B.
2. **Mathematics:** Math 3A, 3B. Social Science majors can take Math 13.
3. **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 1A-B, 2, 3, 4, 10, 12A, 20A-B; Chemistry 1A-B, 12A-B; Physics 2A-B, 4A, 4B, 4C.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

1. **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences of such as Art 2, 3; History 31A-B; Philosophy 20A-B.
2. **Math and Science:** One additional course in each subject.
3. **Modern Languages:** Students in the Natural Science and Mathematics must successfully complete the second course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. Students in Social Sciences must successfully complete the third course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
4. **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 2, 3, 7; Economics 1, 2; Political Science 1, 2, 3, 4; Psychology 1A-B; Sociology 1, 2.
5. **United States:** One course such as African American Studies 1, 5, 29, 30, 31, 32; Asian American Studies 21; English 30A-B, 230A-B; History 7A, 7B, 17, 32; Music 15A, 15B; Political Science 1.
6. **Ethnic or Women's Studies:** One course such as African American Studies 1, 5, 8, 9, 11, 12, 17, 30, 31, 32; Asian American Studies 17, 21, 45A, 45B; English 30A-B, 31; Mexican American Studies 12, 17, 23; Native American Studies 17; Sociology 5.
7. **World Culture/Societies:** One course such as Art 5, 6; Asian American Studies 26, 29, 30; Geography 2; History 5; Political Science 3.
8. **Studio/Performing Arts:** Three semester units such as Art 22, 23, 41, 42, 50, 51, 52, 70, 71, 80, 81; Music 1A-B, 2A-B, 3A-B, 35A-B, 38A-B; Photography 10, Theater Arts 10A-B, 11A-B.
9. Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology and a third course in English Composition are required, but taken at Santa Clara University.
