COLLEGE OF ART & SCIENCES

Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 101A and 101B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 101A, 101B, 101C, 159, 166 or 167.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Astronomy 101A/102, 101B/102; Biology 101A, 101B, 130A, 103B, 104, 106, 130; Chemistry 101A, 101B, 106A, 106B, 112A, 112B; Geography 101/101L; Geology 101/101L, 102/102L, 103/103L; Physical Science 135; Physics 103, 120, 121, 140, 141, 142.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art 103A, 103B; History 104A, 104B; Philosophy 101, 102.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 102, 103; Political Science 102, 103, 105; Psychology 101, 102, 106, 110, 112; Sociology 101, 102.
- 7) **United States:** One course such as Chicano Studies 101, 012, 106A, 112; English 105A; History 112, 114, 115, 117A, 117B, 118; Interdisciplinary Studies 110, 120; Political Science 102,; Sociology 106.
- 8) **Multicultural Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 104; Chicano Studies 101, 102, 106A, 112; English 115; History 112, 114, 115; Interdisciplinary Studies 110, 120; Music 102; sociology 106; Women's Studies 115, 120, 150.
- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 102; Art 103D, 103E; Philosophy 110, 114.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art104A, 104B, 104C, 106A, 106B, 107A, 107B, 108A, 111A, 111B, 112, 116A, 116B, 133A, 133B; Music 111A, 111B, 111C, 160A, 160B, 160C, 160D, 160E, 160F, 161A, 161B, 161C, 161D, 161E, 161F, 162A, 162B, 162C, 162D, 162E, 162F, 163A, 163B, 163C, 163D, 164A, 164B, 164C, 164D, 165A, 165B, 165C, 165D, 166A, 166B, 166C, 166D; Theatre Dance 110, 111, 112, 114, 115A, 116, 132, 140, 141A, 141B, 142A, 142B, 142C, 143A, 143B, 143C, 144A, 144B, 145A2, 145A3, 145A4, 145B2, 145B3, 145B4, 148A2, 148A3, 148B2, 148B3.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Studies, Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology.

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 4) **English:** English 101A and 101B.
- 5) **Mathematics:** Math 101A and 101B. Anthropology, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology major can take Math 159 and 166 and/or 167.
- 6) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Astronomy 101A/102, 101B/102; Biology 101A, 101B, 130A, 103B, 104, 106, 130; Chemistry 101A, 101B, 106A, 106B, 112A, 112B; Geography 101/101L; Geology 101/101L, 102/102L, 103/103L; Physical Science 135; Physics 103, 120, 121, 140, 141, 142.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 102; Art 103D, 103E; Philosophy 110, 114.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art104A, 104B, 104C, 106A, 106B, 107A, 107B, 108A, 111A, 111B, 112, 116A, 116B, 133A, 133B; Music 111A, 111B, 111C, 160A, 160B, 160C, 160D, 160E, 160F, 161A, 161B, 161C, 161D, 161E, 161F, 162A, 162B, 162C, 162D, 162E, 162F, 163A, 163B, 163C, 163D, 164A, 164B, 164C, 164D, 165A, 165B, 165C, 165D, 166A, 166B, 166C, 166D; Theatre Dance 110, 111, 112, 114, 115A, 116, 132, 140, 141A, 141B, 142A, 142B, 142C, 143A, 143B, 143C, 144A, 144B, 145A2, 145A3, 145A4, 145B2, 145B3, 145B4, 148A2, 148A3, 148B2, 148B3.

- 8) **Biological/Physical Science without a Lab, Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Ethnic/Women's Studies, Studio/Performing Arts, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
