**Bachelor of Arts Degree**

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

**The minimum required courses for admission are:**

- 1) **English:** English 100 or 105 and 110.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 200, 251, 252.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 101, 110, 215, 230, 240, 250, 260; Chemistry 112, 192, 210, 220, 234/237, 235/238; Geology 210, 220; Oceanography 100/101; Physics 210, 220, 250, 260, 270.

**Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:**

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences Art 101, 102; History 100, 101; Philosophy 160, 175.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or a modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 110, 155, 180, 360; Economics 102; Political Science 115, 130, 210; Psychology 100, 105, 110, 200, 268, 300, 390, 410; Sociology 100, 105, 108, 110, 141.
- 7) **U. S. History:** One course such as Art 120; History 108, 201, 202, 235, 240, 244, 420; Music 240; Political Science 210.
- 8) **Multicultural Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 180, 360; History 235, 244, 420; Literature 251, 265, 266, 267, 370, 373; Political Science 320; Psychology 268; Social Science 150; Sociology 141.
- 9) **World Cultures/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 110; Art 105; History 430, 435; Philosophy 320; Political Science 115.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 201, 202, 204, 205, 207, 208, 209, 214, 221, 222, 231, 232, 248, 301, 302, 351, 352, 353, 405, 406, 411, 412, 417; Music 301, 302, 303, 304, 350, 351, 377, 378, 379, 401, 402, 403, 404, 430, 450, 470, 475; Dance 101, 110, 130, 140.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

**Bachelor of Science Degree**

**The minimum required courses for admission are:**

- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 251 and 252. Anthropology, Political Science and/or Sociology majors can take Math 200.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One course such as Biology 101, 110, 215, 230, 240, 250, 260; Chemistry 112, 192, 210, 220, 234/237, 235/238; Geology 210, 220; Oceanography 100/101; Physics 210, 220, 250, 260, 270.

**Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:**

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from *one* of the following sequences such as Art 101, 102; History 100, 101; Philosophy 160, 175.
- 5) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course (second course for semester) of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or a modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 6) **Social Science:** One course such as Anthropology 110, 155, 180, 360; Economics 102; Political Science 115, 130, 210; Psychology 100, 105, 110, 200, 268, 300, 390, 410; Sociology 100, 105, 108, 110, 141.
- 7) **U.S. History:** One course such as Art 120; History 108, 201, 202, 235, 240, 244, 420; Music 240; Political Science 210.
- 8) **Multicultural Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 180, 360; History 235, 244, 420; Literature 251, 265, 266, 267, 370, 373; Political Science 320; Psychology 268; Social Science 150; Sociology 141.
- 9) **World Culture/Societies:** One course such as Anthropology 110; Art 105; History 430, 435; Philosophy 320; Political Science 115.
- 10) **Studio/Performing Arts or Music:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 201, 202, 204, 205, 207, 208, 209, 214, 221, 222, 231, 232, 248, 301, 302, 351, 352, 353, 405, 406, 411, 412, 417; Music 301, 302, 303, 304, 350, 351, 377, 378, 379, 401, 402, 403, 404, 430, 450, 470, 475; Dance 101, 110, 130, 140.
- 11) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.
