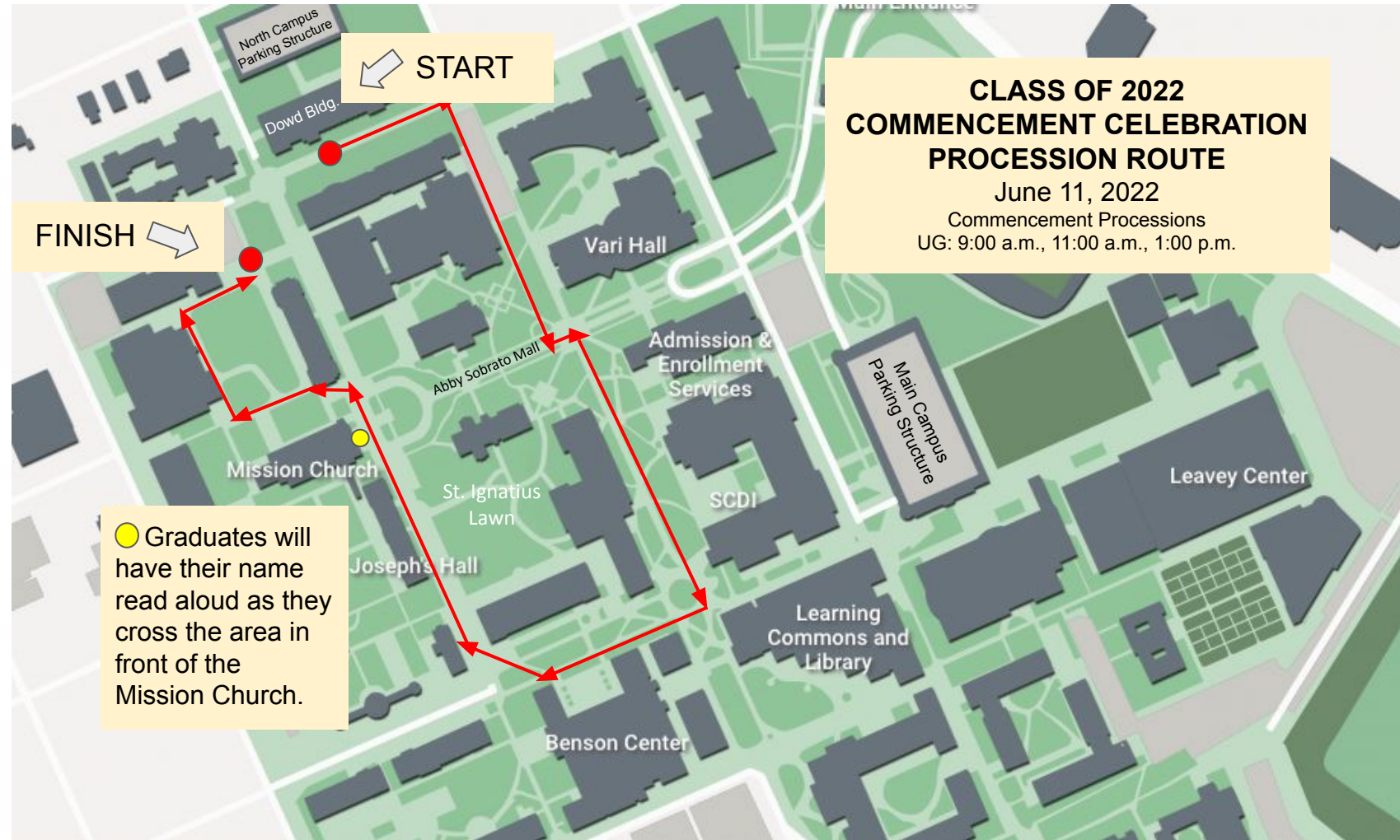

# How Will Graduates Register for Commencement?



## Undergraduates

- In early April, the Commencement Office will email all Undergraduate students with detailed information regarding registration, purchasing attire and communicating all Commencement related deadlines. They will also be notified to look out for an email from Marching Order (the software vendor we use that reads the graduate's name aloud as they cross the stage and also tickets the event.)
- Undergraduates will then be sent a link to register with Marching Order and create a password.
- One week later (at a pre-communicated and specified time), Marching Order will open its registration for SCU's Commencement processions. These procession time slots will be available on a first come, first served basis. Should a procession reach its capacity, it will show as unavailable. We will not be hosting a wait list for graduates, rather- they will have to keep checking back on Marching Order to see if another graduate has cancelled and opened an availability. In addition to choosing a time slot, graduates will edit/approve the phonetic pronunciation of their name, upload a photo for their digital graduation card, and register up to four (4) guests. Once registered, grads can print their GradPass and email guests their tickets.
- The Class of 2022 Grad Bash, hosted by the Alumni Association, will also open its website on the same day for registration. Graduate tickets are complimentary with the option to purchase up to six (6) guest tickets.



## Commencement Related Events

- ❑ **Senior Awards and Toast-**  
Slated for the week of May 30, this event celebrates the impressive accomplishments of our graduating seniors. Our valedictorian will offer remarks and honored faculty and staff will offer a toast to our graduates. An outdoor reception will follow.
- ❑ **Multicultural Recognition Ceremonies-**  
The Office for Multicultural Learning will host a set of festive receptions the week of June 6 to recognize students of color and LGBTQIA+ students in the graduating class.
- ❑ **Campus Liturgy-**  
Graduates and their families are invited to a student planned Liturgy on Friday, June 10 at 5:00 p.m. in the Mission Gardens.
- ❑ **Undergraduate Class of 2022 Grad Bash-**  
The Alumni Association will host a Grad Bash at Bellomy Field on Friday, June 10 at 6:30 p.m. following the Liturgy. Each Undergraduate will be given a complimentary ticket and have the option to purchase up to six (6) guest tickets.
