## PMIN 205: Ecclesiology

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## **Course Description:**

This course provides theological foundations in ecclesiology. Topics covered include models of the church, the missionary nature of the church, lay and ordained ministry, authority in the church, synodality, and ecumenism. Particular attention is given to the ecclesiology of the Second Vatican Council and postconciliar developments. This course fulfills the Ecclesiology requirement for the MA degree.

## **Required texts:**

- The documents of the Second Vatican Council. Recommended translation is Austin Flannery's inclusive translation (1996). The documents can be accessed online at www.vatican.va as well.
- Other texts will be available on Camino.

## **Learning Goals:**

This course primarily addresses two learning goals of the Graduate Program in Pastoral Ministry's MA Degree:
