


OUR MISSION

The Boggs Tract Community Farm offers the opportunity for neighborhood families to learn gardening techniques and become shareholders in the farm. In addition to family plots PUENTES is developing the farm as a sustainable business which will bring future job opportunities to the community. Farm projects include the production of vegetable and fruit crops, eggs and fish.

GET STARTED WITH A FAMILY PLOT

A small vegetable garden can provide a bounty of food for a household. Family plots offer the opportunity for families to grow their own food and gain gardening experience. Plots on the Boggs Tract Community Farm are available to families who are willing to commit the time necessary to develop and maintain them year round. Classes, training and professional advice are provided by the farm staff and through the UC Davis Master Gardener Program. There is a \$20 annual fee which covers water and soil. Financial assistance is available.

COMMUNITY SUPPORTED AGRICULTURE

The Boggs Tract Community Farm is committed to selling produce through a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program run by its shareholders. Customers of this program will receive a box of produce monthly for a fee. Proceeds from the sale of CSA boxes help fund the farm. Shareholder families are required to help maintain the farm and participate in general operations which support the CSA.
