JST-SCU Student Expense Budget (Cost of Attendance) for the 2025-2026 Academic Year

The following is an estimate of each student's cost of attendance, which you should keep for reference. This budget calculates expenses for financial aid and loan applications and determines international students' economic needs. It assists JST-SCU students in estimating their budgetary requirements for the academic year. This budget is for the 9-month academic year only. As these costs are only estimates, individual budgets may vary.
