COUNSELING PRINCIPALS & PASTORAL CARE FOR VICTIMS OF TRAUMA

IDS-2100 (1 unit)

This course will explore the experience of trauma, including its physical, cognitive, emotional, behavioral and spiritual consequences. Counseling approaches will be presented for assisting persons impacted by traumatic experiences – wartime violence, sexual assault, intimate partner violence, childhood or elder abuse, community or political violence, etc. Case studies and role-playing will augment theory and counseling principles. ARCHBISHOP ROMERO AND THE UCA MARTYRS ST-4198 (3 units)

This hybrid course will explore how Archbishop Romero and the UCA martyrs historicized God's "preferential option for the poor" after Vatican II during the U.S.-sponsored war in El Salvador. Jon Sobrino, S.J., describes Lassalle-Klein's analysis as "magnificent," while Kevin Burke, S.J. adds, "sweeping, ... unsettling, ... and profound in its theological depth." Students will meet UCA faculty via zoom and experience a virtual tour of where the martyrs lived and died.
