- a. AMP Park (mobile payment system)
  - i. Statistics and feedback
    - 1. Promo Code (Natalie)

The AMP Park APP or website: [aimsmobilepay.com](https://aimsmobilepay.com) has replaced the previously used parking code option at the pay and display stations. Departments may submit a request for a promo code through our [Promo Code Request Form](#), and pay up front for use in either the parking garages (\$9 per use) or overflow surface lots (\$6 per use). The code may be used for a single event or rolled over across multiple events throughout the fiscal year. P&TS is confirming with the Finance office if promo codes can be rolled over to the next fiscal year.

## **5. Reserved spaces for Men's Basketball**

- a. Leavey Parking Lot

P&TS has communicated with the campus through email and newsletters regarding the space reservations for Men's Basketball home games only. Athletics has paid for these space reservations to support men's basketball games. The majority of parking permit holders that would be required to move their vehicles are "F" parking permit holders. The Guadalupe Hall parking lot is the next closest surface parking lot to the Leavey Parking Lot.

### **Questions/comments/concerns from constituent groups?**

- A transportation survey (co-sponsored by the Center for Sustainability) will be sent to all advisory committee members for review and edits by 1/26/26.
- The stop sign in the North Campus Garage is not placed well on the Alviso Street side. An advisory committee member suggested that trimming the hedges and some restriping work may be needed for the stop sign to be more effective. Lastly, there was a recommendation to add a painted crosswalk when crossing from one isle to another towards the elevators in the North Campus Garage.
- An advisory member said that the parking consultant will audit the spaces to check the demand for B spaces on the first floor of the North Campus garage. Another advisory member followed up with the suggestion to possibly switch the Ignation Center's spaces

currently on the first floor of the North Campus garage to the top of the garage so B spaces can be allocated there.

- The Alternative Transit Packs will replace the alternative transit card and are to be launched in February.
- P&TS will continue to meet with Caltrain to continue the conversation about purchasing train tickets for a subset of individuals.
