- Five upper-division ARTH courses
- Two additional lower- or upper-division ARTH courses
- ARTH 196 (senior year)

Note: Of the courses labeled ARTH, at least two must be taken from courses numbered 21--22 or 101--139 (premodern era). Of the five required upper-division ARTH, one must be from 101--139, one must be from 141, 142, 146, or 150--179 (global area), and one must be 106, 112, or 120 (advanced writing in the discipline).
