Studio Art Major with Graphic Design Emphasis

Studio art majors have the option of completing a graphic design emphasis within the major by taking 3 specific graphic design courses as part of the studio art major's six ARTS elective courses. Like the general studio art major, the graphic design emphasis requires the four foundation ARTS courses, four ARTH courses, ARTS 100, 190, and 196, and six additional studio ARTS elective courses; however, 3 of the elective courses need to be specific to graphic design as listed below. Completion of the emphasis will be noted on the student's transcript. The graphic design emphasis is for studio art majors only.
