The academic year is divided into 3 quarters: Fall, Winter, and Spring. Student exchange applications to SCU for the academic year will attend Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters.

Course Load and Grading

Per quarter, the minimum course load is 12 units and the maximum course load is 19 units, with letter grades A-F.

Exams and Transcripts

Exams occur during the last week of the quarter. Transcripts are released after grades are received, and the student must not have a hold on their account. This should be no later than 1 month after exams.

Student Registration

Once students receive their acceptance materials from SCU, information will be provided on how to register for courses at SCU.

Application and Visas

Application Requirements

Students are required to complete the <u>Santa Clara University: Incoming Exchange Student Application</u>. Students will upload their scanned supplemental materials to their application. Hardcopies are not required.

Visa Requirements

Students with questions regarding the visa process and completing the proper documents should visit the <u>International Students and Scholars website</u>.

Health Insurance Requirements

Comprehensive health insurance is required by the U.S. government as well as Santa Clara University. All international students in F-1 or J-1 status are automatically enrolled in and charged for the SCU Student Health Insurance Plan. This cannot be waived, and students should budget accordingly.
