| Denmark: Copenhagen-Child Development and Diversity/DIS | Coursework in areas like Adolescence in Europe, Child Development in Scandinavia, Children in a Multicultural Context, as well as humanities courses. | Homestay, research and engagement in community. |
| Ecuador: Quito-International Development & Internship/UMN | Coursework in international development with focus on education and literacy with built in internship or research. All coursework conducted in Spanish. | Homestay, internships, research, intensive language and engagement in community. |
| Senegal: Dakar - International Development and Internship/UMN | Coursework in international development with focus on education and literacy with built in internship or research. All coursework conducted in French. | Homestay, internships, research, intensive language and engagement in community. |
| United Arab Emirates: Sharjah - Business, Engineering, Arts & Sciences/CIEE | Coursework in areas like philosophy of education, teaching and learning in an electronic environment, classroom discourse, etc., Arabic language as well as access to university wide curriculum. | Classes at local university, engagement in community. |
