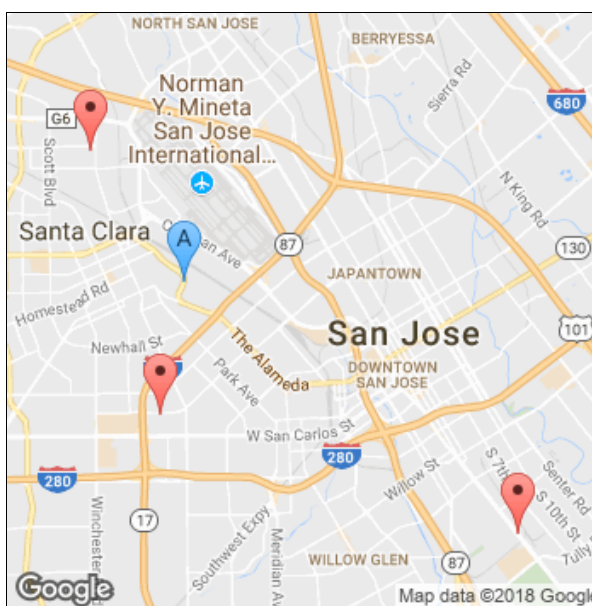
California State Certified Medical Provider Network (MPN)


If the employer is utilizing the Travelers certified MPN, the employee must choose a provider from the list of providers within the approved network, the **TravNet MPN**, unless the employee has chosen a pre-designated physician prior to the injury. Employers who utilize a certified MPN can direct the injured worker's care for the life of the claim.
