




Between 2015-16 and 2023-24, Santa Clara added 124 Pell students.





# **Graduation and Retention Rates: Overall and Pell**


Santa Clara and its Peers



In the most recent year, Santa Clara's six-year Pell graduation rate was higher than its overall six-year grad rate and higher than its peers' average six-year Pell grad rate. Santa Clara's Pell retention rate was lower than its overall retention rate but equal to its peers' average Pell retention rate.
